


So he sat down near a well to rest while his disciples went into town to buy food.

The woman was surprised. "You are a Jew and I am a Samaritan woman! YOU are asking ME for a drink of water?"



Jesus answered her, "If you knew who I was, you would ask me for living water."


Now the woman was even more amazed. "Living water? You do not even have a bucket! How will you get this water? Are you greater than our ancestors that built this well?"

The woman hung her head in shame. "I don't have a husband."


Jesus said to her, "You are right when you say you have no husband. The fact is, you have five husbands and the man you live with now is not your husband."

"Woman," Jesus replied, "soon it will not matter where you worship. God is spirit, so you can worship Him anywhere, as long as you worship him in spirit and in truth."




"I know the Messiah is coming soon. When he comes, He will explain everything to us," the woman said.
