Jesus Feeds the 5,000

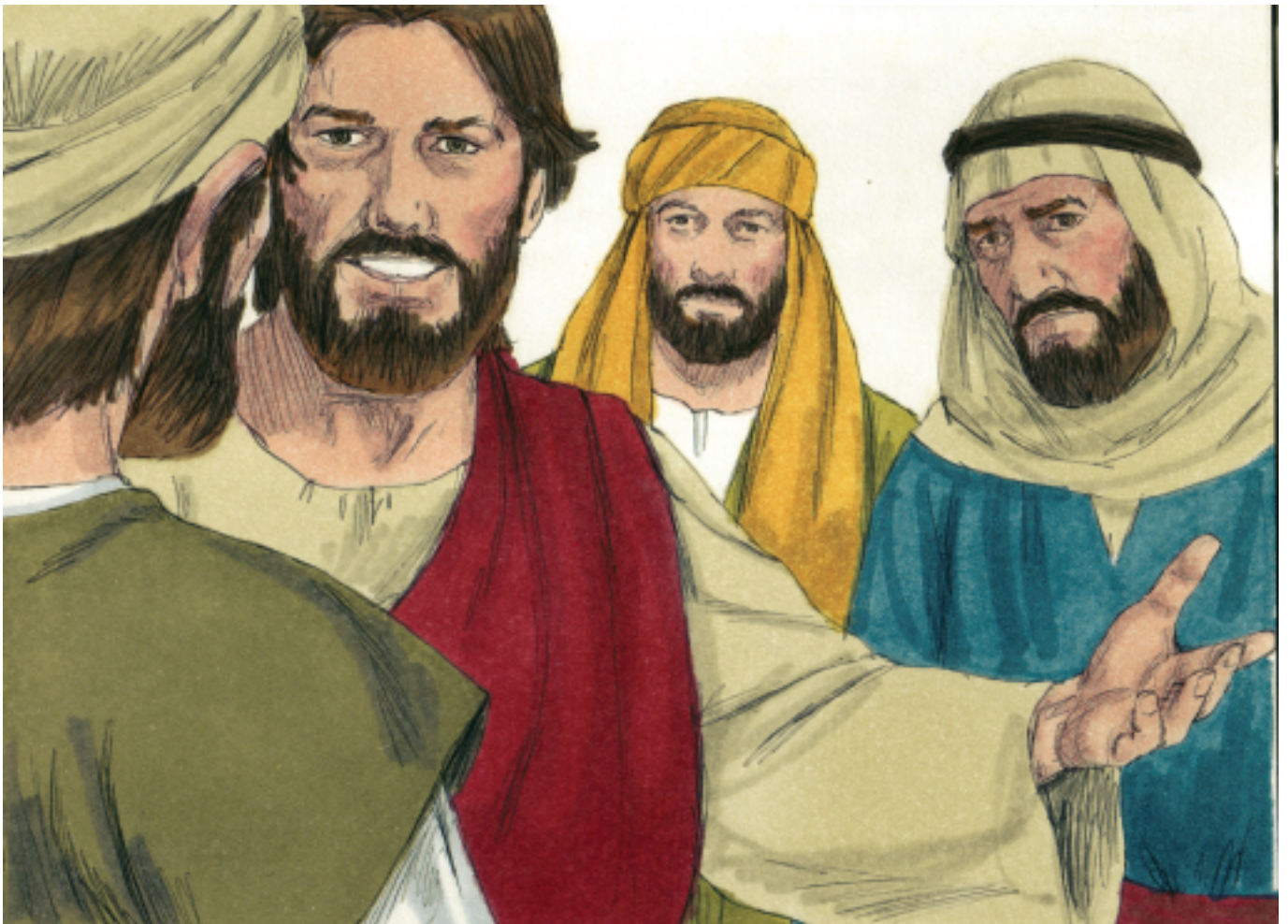
John 6:1-15

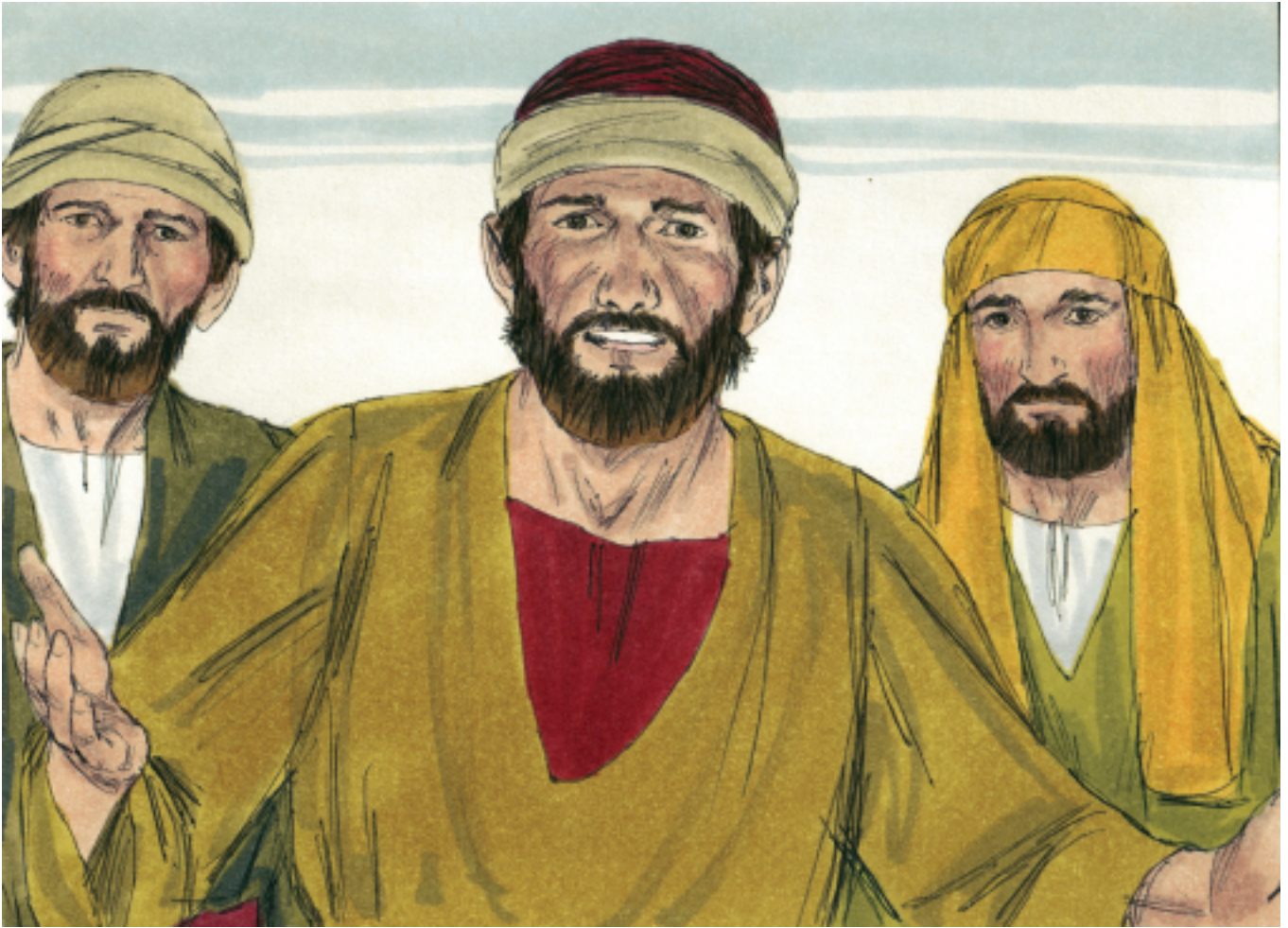


Jesus was healing people who were sick, or disabled, or blind, and a large crowd was following him to see him do miracles.

At this particular time, it was Passover, which is special day for the Jews in which they have a feast.

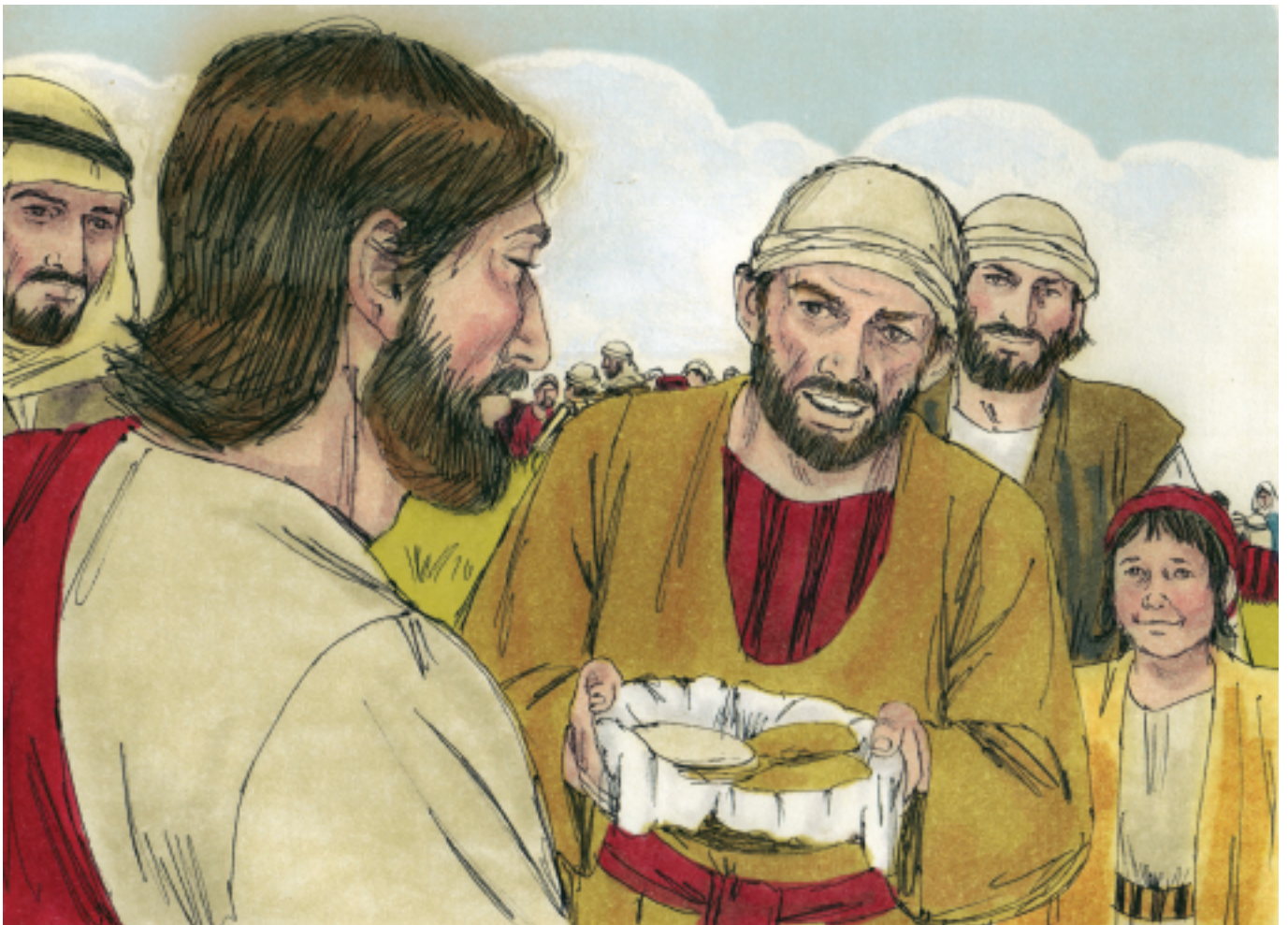

Philip answered him, "It would take 8 months to make enough money to pay for the food for all these people! And even then, it would just be a little for each person!"

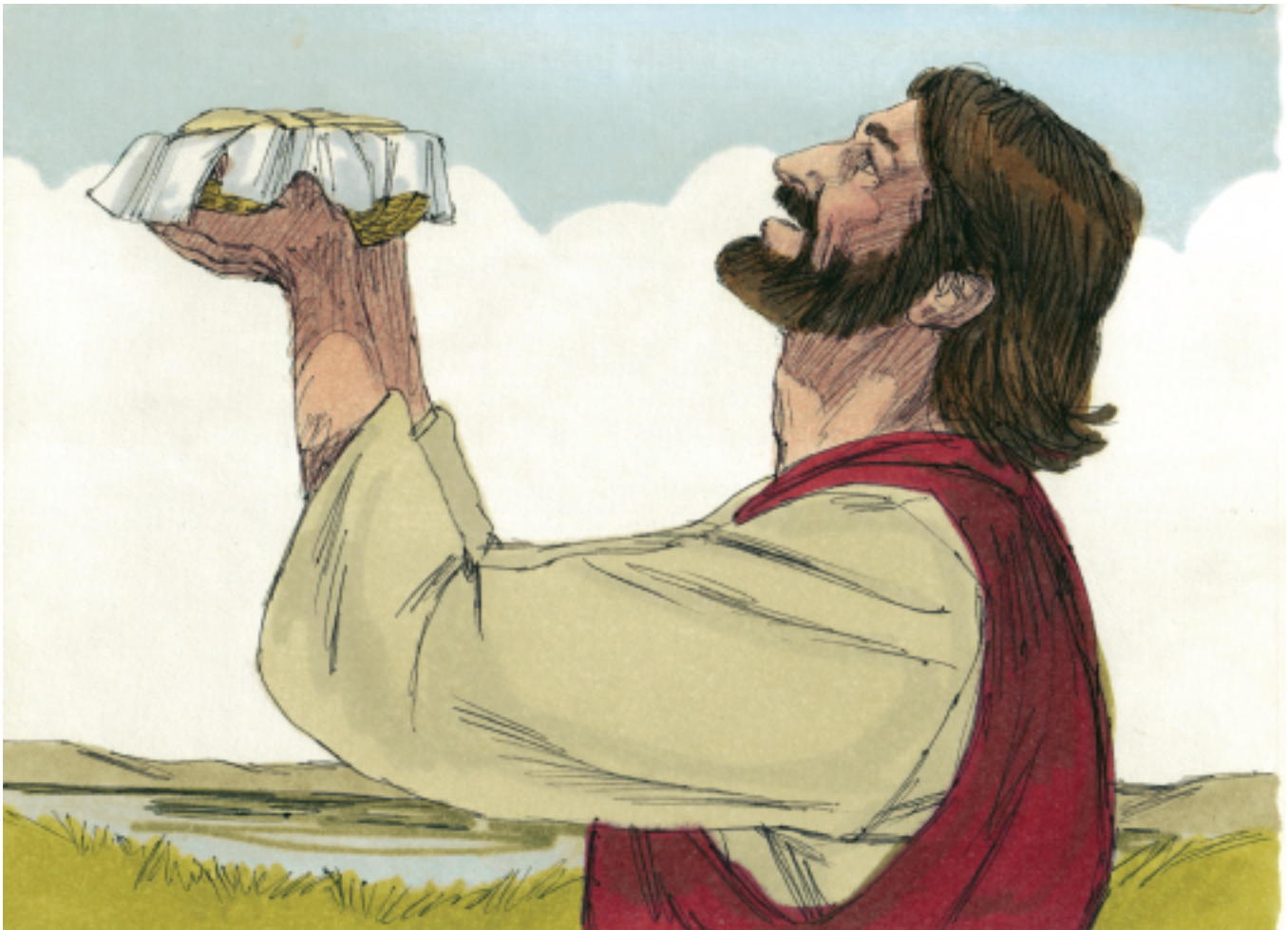
Another disciple, Andrew, said, “Lord, here is a boy who has five barley loaves and two fish...but what good will that be with so many people?”
