

## DAY7: Jesus Walks on Water John 6:16-40

Jesus did not go with them. Instead, he decided to spend some time alone and pray.


As the disciples rowed the boat across the lake, it got dark. A strong wind was blowing, and the waves got bigger.





After the disciples rowed about 3 miles, they saw Jesus coming up to them, walking on the water! The disciples were afraid.


But Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid. It's me. It's Jesus!"




Then the disciples let Jesus come onto the boat. As soon as he did, the boat reached the shore they were heading! It was another miracle!

When the crowd found Jesus, they asked him, "Teacher! When did you get here?"








Then they asked him, "What things do we have to do to get this eternal life?"
