Father,

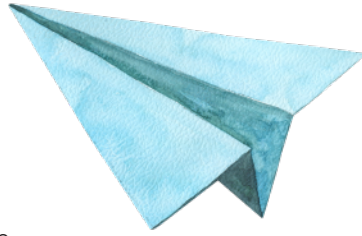
You have placed me in this community, this neighborhood, this class, and this social circle with intentionality.

## When I Want to Quit

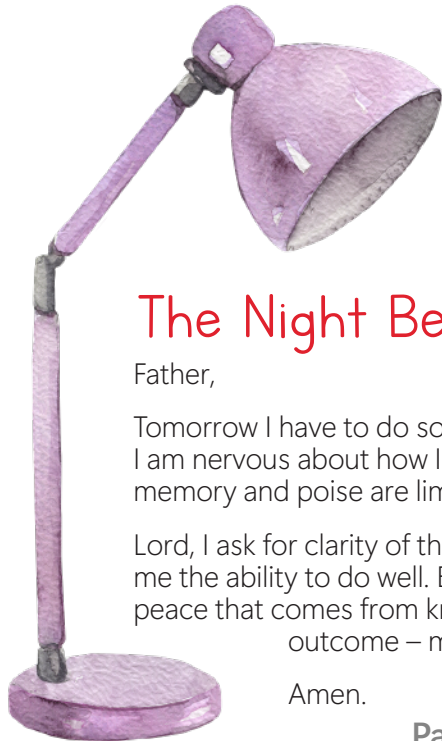
Father,

Father,

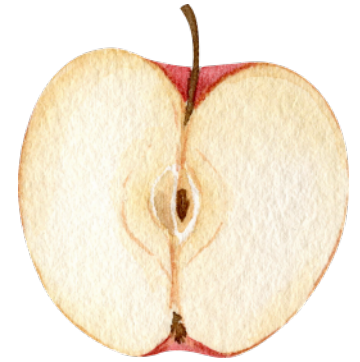
We know that teachers have a special role and calling. They have the opportunity to influence and mold lives in ways that few professions offer.
