\star	 1 Thessalonians 5:17 What does it mean to pray "continually" (or "without ceasing")? What part of the day do you think you could pray more in?
\star	 Romans 8:26 Have you ever felt so sad you didn't know how to pray? How does it feel to know that the Holy Spirit does this for us?
\star	 Matthew 6:5 What does this kind of prayer look like in today's context? What "reward" did the hypocrites receive?
\star	 Matthew 6:6 Why do you think it is important to pray alone sometimes? What reward to you think God will give those who pray in secret?
\star	 Matthew 6:7 What does this kind of prayer sound like in today's context? How can you be sure you are avoiding this kind of prayer?
\star	 Matthew 6:8 If God knows what we need before we ask, should we still pray? Why or why not?
*	 Matthew 6:9 Put this phrase into your own words. Why do you think it is important to say something like "hallowed be your name" when you pray?
\star	 Matthew 6:10 Put this phrase in your own words. Why do you think it is important to acknowledge God's sovereignty when you pray?
\star	 Matthew 6:11 Put this phrase in your own words. What types of requests does Jesus want us to make when we pray?

	 Luke 11:11-13 What kinds of good gifts has God given you? Have you ever been afraid to ask God for something?
	 Jeremiah 33:3 Can we ask God for knowledge, wisdom, or understanding? In what ways can God give us the knowledge we desire?
	 1 Timothy 2:1 What do you think the difference between petitions, prayers, intercession, and thanksgiving are? Do your prayers tend to favor one of those categories?
	 1 Timothy 2:2-5 According to these verses, who should we pray for? What should we pray for our leaders about?
	 James 5:13 When should we pray? Is there any time when it is not a good idea to pray?
	 James 5:14-15 Who is someone that you know that is sick? Should you pray for them? Or is it just a job for elders?

\star	 Matthew 18:19-20 Do you think God thinks it is important for Christians to pray when they are together? Why or why not?
\star	 1 John 5:14 What kinds of things might stop us from approaching God? What do you think it means to ask "according to his will"?
\star	 Mark 1:35 Why do you think Jesus chose this way to pray? Why was prayer important to Jesus?
\star	 Proverbs 15:29 What does this verse warn us about? Do you think that prayer is a "cause" or an "effect" of being a righteous person?
\star	 Isaiah 59:2 What does this verse warn us about? If sin has separated us, how can we be reunited with God?
