Jesus Turns Water to Wine

John 2:1-11

In today's story, Jesus and his disciples attend a wedding in a city called Cana. Jesus's mother, Mary, was at the wedding too.

In those days, weddings took a whole week to celebrate! The family and friends would eat and drink wine and celebrate for day after day!





Well, during the wedding party, something sad happened. They ran out of wine!

This was a really big deal to the family celebrating the wedding. It was very embarrassing to run out of wine.

Mary, Jesus's mother said to him, "They have no wine."

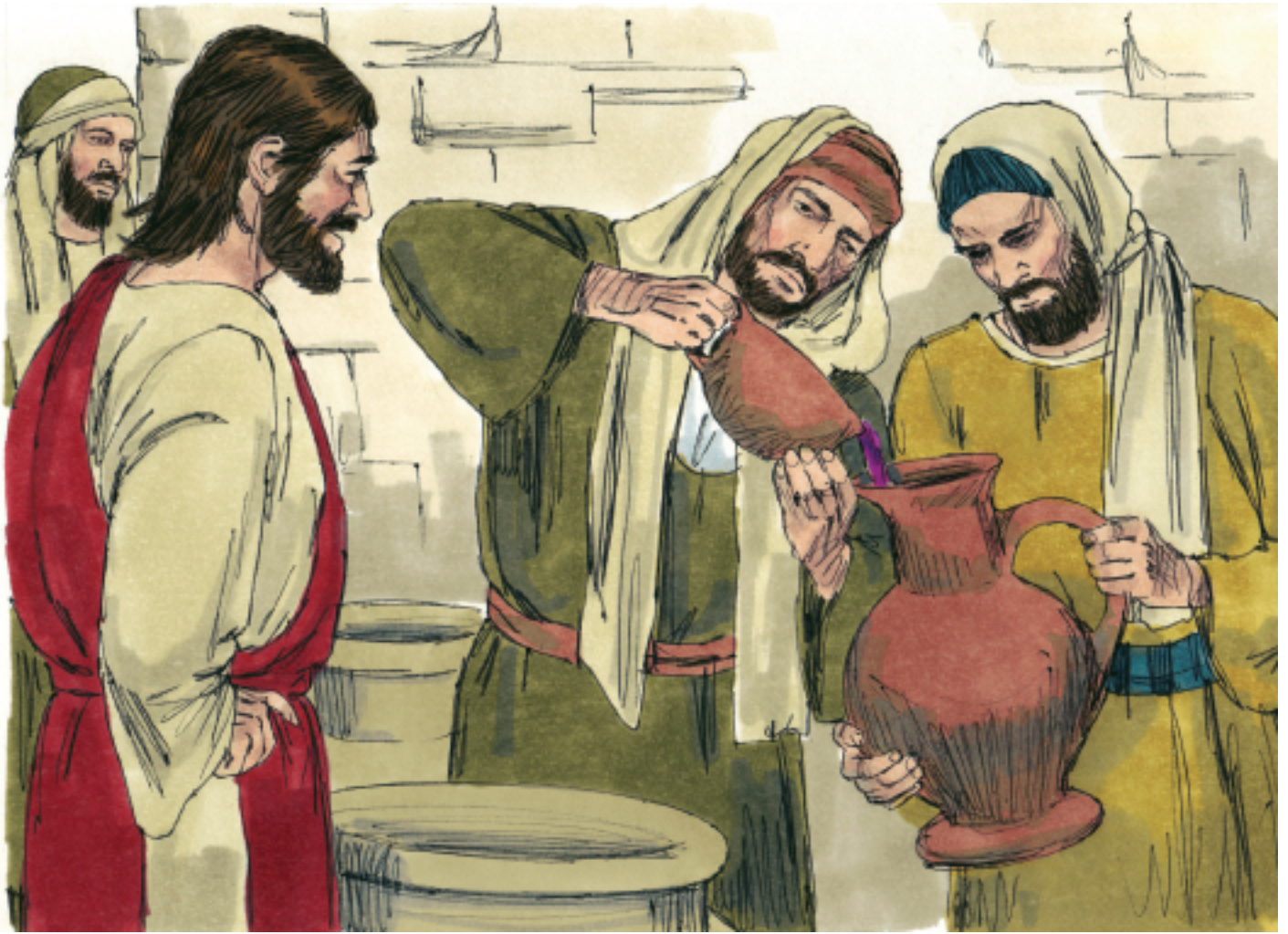
Jesus answered her, "My dear mother, that is none of my business."

Jesus told the servants, "Fill up these big jars with water." The servants filled the jars up to the very top with water.





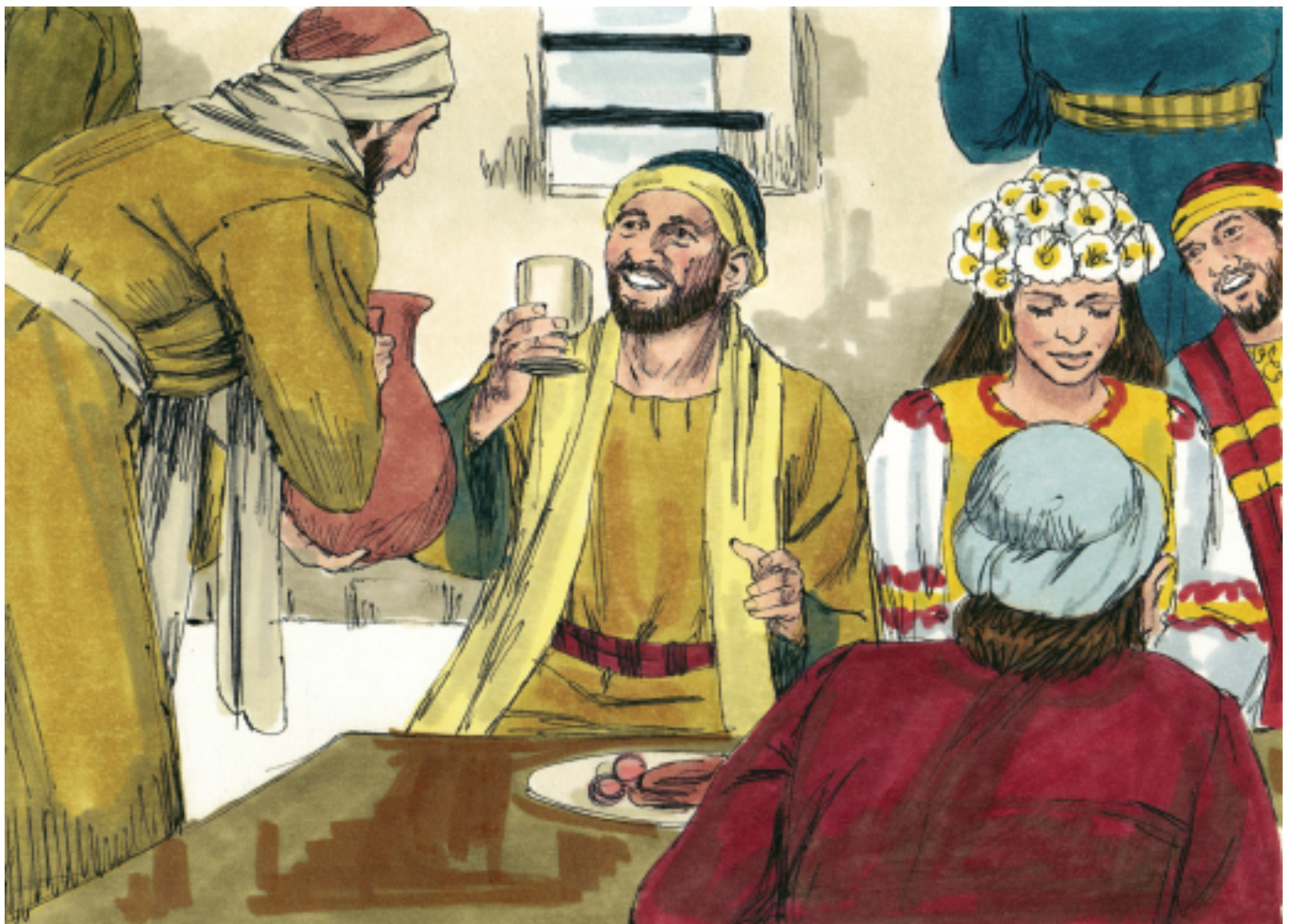
Then Jesus said to them, “Now, take some of it out and bring it to the master of the feast to drink.”
