

## DAY 3: Jesus Teaches Nicodemus John 3:1-21

**KEY VERSES:** JOHN 3:14-15

Trace this verse:

JUST AS

MOSES LIFTED

UP THE SNAKE

IN THE

WILDERNESS,

SO THE SON

OF MAN MUST

BE LIFTED UP,

THAT

EVERYONE

WHO BELIEVES &

MAY HAVE

ETERNAL LIFE

IN HIM.

When did Moses "lift up a snake" and why did he do it? Read Numbers 21:1-9

The author of John uses these words "lifted up" three times in the book, and in each case it has a "double meaning". What do you think the two meanings are? (The three times are John 3:14, John 8:28, John 12:32. Also, look at Isaiah 52:13!)

Jesus is using the story of Moses lifting up the snake to teach Nicodemus something about saving belief. What do you think Jesus telling Nicodemus about salvation that he didn't understand?
